**Describe the project and what will be done or happen.:** This will be a daylong event where citizens, artists, and activists collaborate to temporarily transform metered parking spaces into a parklet. REALTORS@ will help with set up and managing the day long event.

What are the goals of the project?: With Covid-19 posing a real treat to community gathering it is important for us to become innovative in our approach to reimagine how streets can be used by the public. The goal is to repurpose public space, especially in areas where access to parks and open space is limited. Also to increase foot traffic, and revenues, for adjacent businesses.

What are the plans for converting this temporary project into a long-term or permanent project? : This parklet recommendation is a part of the effort led by REALTOR/Councilor Kimberly Alexander to provide safe and beneficial pedestrian improvements to the City of Bessemer neighborhoods and throughout district 2. This project will be used in conversations with the City of Bessemer and the business to negotiate the feasibility of implementing a parklet at this location, as well as other location in Bessemer. This type of intervention is increasingly important due to the recent COVID-19 epidemic and the necessary support for businesses and the provision of safe outdoor spaces for pedestrians. City of Bessemer lead by Councilwoman Kimberly Alexander of district 2 has promised to evaluate the success of the project and if citizens participate they will push for the conversion of public space to people space in district 2.
